- 1. Full Playing Members (of the Reciprocal Club) are entitled to unrestricted use of the course (without payment of a green) and Clubhouse facilities if the duration of their visit is no more than one (1) month, or if their stay is longer than one month they are entitled to Temporary Membership for a period of not more than three years.
- 2. If a Member of the Reciprocal Club holds a Membership other than full playing rights, the same restriction applying to that form of Membership may be granted.
- 3. Members of the Reciprocal Club must produce a Membership Card or a letter of Introduction from their home club to the office on arrival at the Club being visited. They must also report to the office on each subsequent visit.
- 4. For the purpose of these Terms and Conditions visits are categorised as short term or long term. The specific terms and conditions applicable to each category are as follows.

• Short Term Visits

- 1. Duration up to one month.
- 2. Subscription nil.
- 3. Visitors; 3 visitors at any one time on payment of the Member Introduced Green Fee.
- 4. Competitions; providing an Australian handicap is held, Members of the Reciprocal Club are eligible to enter all events other than Honour Board Events.

• Longer Term Visits

- 1. Duration after one month to three years.
- 2. Subscription is normal subscription plus a loading of 25% payable quarterly.
- 3. Visitors; as per short term.
- 4. Competitions; as per short term.
- 5. Membership; Temporary Membership will be granted but this will cease automatically after 3 years. If the Temporary Member wishes to apply for Ordinary Membership he/she must do so before the three years expire in accordance with the normal membership procedures ie Proposer, Seconder and 3 referees all of who must be Full Members of the Club. Election to Ordinary Membership will require the payment of an Entrance Fee less the amount of the 25% loading set out in paragraph 4b (2) above.
