- 1. Each club shall extend to its reciprocal members, all the privileges to the golf course and other club facilities usually given to its own members in the equivalent category of membership to which the visiting member is entitled to at his/her own club. Only members with playing rights have the entitlement under the terms of this agreement.
- 2. A member who normally resides within 100 kilometres of the reciprocal club shall not be entitled to the reciprocal benefits provided for under this agreement.
- 3. A reciprocal member will be required to provide a letter of introduction stating proof of membership and current handicap details from the home club.
- 4. Reciprocal benefits shall extend for a period not exceeding 30 days from date of letter in any one calendar year or as otherwise determined by each club, with a maximum of six games per year.
- 5. A member visiting a reciprocal club shall be subject to the Rules, By-Laws and other authoritative controls in effect at the club at the time.
- 6. A reciprocal member shall be required to pay such entry/competition fees as are applicable to club members.
- 7. Reciprocal members will be exempt from the payment of green fees subject to the restrictions and playing rights applicable to their equivalent category of membership at the reciprocal club.
- 8. A reciprocal member shall be ineligible to compete in major club/inter club championships or win club perpetual or inter-club trophies.
- 9. A reciprocal member may introduce one visitor any day except Saturday and such visitor shall pay the normal green fee application to a guest playing with a club member.
- 10. No joining rights are granted to members of either club, except in accordance with the rules and By-Laws of each club and payment of the applicable fee.
