

The Brisbane Golf Club Motorised Cart Guidelines 'Dry Conditions'

Members, welcome to the Brisbane Golf Club cart guidelines. This booklet is designed to provide cart users with a guide for cart use on the course.

If you have any questions from the guide please don't hesitate to ask a member of staff from the golf shop or a member of the committee.

These guidelines apply in 'dry conditions', please note, our process for wet conditions remains unchanged and members will be advised through the golf shop of the guidelines for cart use. The committee has consulted with our Course Superintendant Mitch Hayes to get his opinion on the effect of cart traffic on the course. In short he is quite comfortable that carts are free to proceed anywhere on the course keeping in mind some common sense principles and acknowledging there are some 'No Go Zones' on the course.

The purpose of this guideline is to outline these 'No Go Zones' and common sense principles around the course.

The Club spends a significant amount of your membership dollars on maintaining the course and the surrounds in a condition befitting a private members golf course. We are conscious that buggy signs, ropes etc do not add to the look of a quality golf course. We also acknowledge that The Brisbane Golf Club members wish to enjoy their game and use a cart. With the support of all members we believe a happy balance can be reached for all parties.

With this in mind the guidelines have been produced accordingly. We trust that the new guidelines provide some relaxation in areas where buggies do not cause significant issues for the course, yet highlights areas of the course that require appropriate protection.

We appreciate that the majority of members are cognisant of buggy guidelines and we look forward to the support of all cart users.

Unfortunately, history shows that there are some who will continue to show fellow members and the course staff disrespect. We will be more diligently applying the code of conduct around the use of carts. This process is outlined in the Fixture Book and on the website.

As a committee we will be enforcing the penalties to those who continue to disrespect fellow members.



General Common Sense Rules

- As a general rule no carts should be driven within 5 meters of any green or bunker.
- When using a path, your cart remains entirely on the path and not driven or parked as shown.
