These days would not have the wonderful atmosphere if it weren't for the work of Margot McNee, Robyn Cuming and Cath Reidy. Their ability to transform the room is magical, and we are all very appreciative. These ladies also ensure our locker room is well presented, with fresh flowers and supplies of toiletries and so on. I must also acknowledge the tireless work of Irene Raymond. I note in the Club history that Irene has been running our library since 2004, and we have an incredible range of literature available to us to borrow. Thank you, Irene.

Without going any further I would like to acknowledge the Ladies' Committee who have all worked tirelessly in their roles to ensure all our various golfing and social commitments are met. This group not only are involved in

the organisation of the ladies' golf, social events, Ladies, Let's Golf, communications and finance, but they also have been invited to be on the sub-committees of the Club. These sub-committees work to recognise problems and identify improvements for the whole Club which then are tabled at the General Committee for approval. The initiative of making our Monthly Medal days and special event days in the Tennyson Room has been one way to sustain this tradition.

Communication with our members continues to be paramount to our community. The Red Tees, produced monthly, has been sensational and a tribute to Anna Lyons

and Angela Cottrell who manage to produce new, interesting, and entertaining stories every month for us. This newsletter also provides a reference for upcoming events and past results for our community. Thank you for your extraordinary efforts. The Club now adds this newsletter to the "Latest News" on the website for all to enjoy. The increasing use of the "Notifications" feature, Facebook, Instagram and the website are all helping to keep us connected.

# Captain's Report



From the moment I was nominated for the position of Captain to now it is hard to believe that more than two years have passed. One could never imagine a couple of years so different from others in our recent memory. Thankfully we have competed with lockdowns and diverse weather conditions to get all our competitions in for this year. With the help of Alan Grieve, our Club Captain, and the staff of the Brisbane Golf Club we were able to play all the events that were listed in our calendar, though we did need to extend into October and November to do so.

We started the year with modified handicap ranges with A-Grade ranging from plus to 23; B-Grade from 24 to 33; and C-Grade from 34 to 45. I monitored the results of all our competitions on a weekly basis throughout the year and it showed these to be a fairer distribution and there were more competitive

results with the changes. Both our Opening Days on Saturday, 6 February and Tuesday, 9 February set us up for a very successful and exciting 2021. We had a full field on both days followed by a very enjoyable lunch. All members were excited to start the new season.

It is always good to start our year with a friendly match and the Clare Kirkwood 4BBB Presidents vs Captains Team Challenge does just that. I am happy to report the Captain's Team won 14 to 12 with one tied match.

On 23 February we had our first Monthly Medal. It was good to get an early start with our Monthly Medals as, with hindsight, we needed to change so many of them throughout the year for various reasons. More often than not the skies would open up at the mention of a Monthly Medal. Congratulations to all those who won a medal and to our Medal of Medallists in A, B and C Grade, well done.

As usual, our Pennant season organisation began early in the year and Brisbane Golf Club is so proud of the continuing achievements of our players, caddies, and non-playing captains. I made a prediction early on and stated our Pennant teams this year were awesome. I am proud to say that our Gold, Silver and Weekend Two Teams won their Pennants and our Bronze Team only lost by  $\frac{1}{2}$  a point. The

Weekend One Team also made us proud, but it was tough for them as they lost players to the Club Championships that were on at the same time.

I would like to take this time to thank all those who helped along the way. The players, their caddies, the non-playing captains and those who helped so much on the three days that we hosted the Pennants at Brisbane Golf Club. You can't come away from a Pennant season with such great victories without the commitment that we had from everyone. This year our Pennant teams' trip away was held at Royal Pines on 7 and 8 October. I am sure everyone who came along enjoyed themselves and we celebrated a great season in style.

The Club Championship format this year was two rounds of stroke followed by the top eight in each division playing match play for the quarter finals, semi-finals and finals. With the first two qualifying rounds we also played our Senior Salver, with a record number of players making it a very competitive field. Congratulations to Beverley Deane for winning the Salver this year.

Our women's match play was played in conjunction with the men's match play starting on Sunday, 12 June. It was great to see so many players and spectators out on the course over three Sundays of competition.



Congratulations to Lesa Lambert who is our Club Champion for 2021, our B Grade Champion, Jenny Somers and our C Grade Champion, Susan Gargett. This year was the first year in a long time that we fielded a Girls Junior Championship and congratulations to Kiara Smith for winning that event. With a full field of 46 pairs playing the 36-hole Club Foursomes Championship on Tuesday 29 June our champions played two rounds of exceptional golf. Our Club Foursomes winners were Hannah Reeves and Erica Vedelago with a gross score of 166. Our nett winners with a net score of 142 were Susan Eagleton and Anna Lyons.

The Brisbane Cup was played on 5 September with 20 players from different clubs competing for both the Brisbane Cup and the Brisbane Salver. Seion Kim from Oxley Golf Club won both events and our own Morgan Lewis was runner up in both events losing by only one shot.

I would also like to congratulate all winners of our Honour Board and special events listed below. It is so important that every year we celebrate those who have had a chance to compete in and win in these events. Having the opportunity to referee most of these events I can see how the players look forward to the match play and how special it becomes.

This year we were able to run both our inter-club events. It was Royal Queensland's turn to host the game and they

proved course knowledge is so important with a convincing win over BGC. Royal Queensland were wonderful hosts, and all enjoyed the day.

Our inter-club match against Indooroopilly was held on 23 August, with 40 pairs from Indooroopilly joining us at home for a 4BBB competition and lunch provided by Rudy and the Club's hospitality staff. This time it was Brisbane's turn to use course knowledge and Brisbane Golf Club won for the second time in a row. Thank you to the Ladies' Committee for all their help with the morning tea and to Rudy and the team for all their efforts to make it a very successful day.
